From September 2nd / 3rd the weekend schedule will be as follows:

**Sunday: 9.00am in Carrigerry**  
**Sunday: 11.00am in Newmarket**

Unfortunately change such as this makes it impossible to accommodate the wishes of everybody and brings inconvenience to some. We will observe for a few weeks how this change is progressing. Hopefully we can manage to adjust as best we can until a new normality is established.
