Meals on Wheels Church

Gate Collection: The Obair South Clare Community Catering Service (Meals on Wheels) began operating from Café Fergus in 2010 supplying 10 meals to local people in the Newmarket on Fergus area.

Since expanding the service to other areas 2 years ago they now supply over 60 meals per day Monday to Friday in the wider South Clare area. The service delivers a two course hot meal daily to anyone who may not be in a position to cook for themselves due to increasing age, illness or hospital recovery. The meals are nutritious and cooked fresh to very high standards and are offered at a low cost.
