Men's Shed: Over the last few months, a handful of local men/lads have started a local branch of men's shed. This endeavour has been spearheaded by P.J. McMahon. Premises have been generously made available by Carrigoran House, and have been upgraded to an

acceptable standard for safe use. Machines, tools, work benches have been also donated by various people and businesses. It is hoped to get affiliated to 'Irish Men's Sheds Association.'

The aims of Men's Sheds are: A Men's Shed is any community-based, non-commercial organisation which is open to all adult members of the local community, where the primary activity is the provision of a safe, friendly and inclusive environment where the members are able to gather and/or work on meaningful projects at their own pace, in their own time and in the company of other members and where the primary objective is to advance the health and well-being of all participating members.

The first meeting was back in March, and thereafter meetings are every Tuesday and Thursday from 10.00 am to 2.30 pm.

Various tasks are taken on such as, upholstery (basic), restoration, repairs, making of various garden items, Dovecotes, bird boxes, flower barrows, window boxes etc. All these items are for sale from the workshop in Carrigoran.

### Tidy Towns welcome village water main rehabilitation

project: Tidy Towns have given a warm welcome to the commencement of the village water main rehabilitation project. Irish Water have confirmed that work is scheduled to commence before Christmas on replacing old damaged water mains on the Main Street/Ballycar Road. The work is being carried out under the National Leakage Reduction Programme and involves replacing old damaged water pipes with new plastic (polyethylene) pipes. The water main project has an end date of early February 2018. Post provision of the water main project, the road improvements/ road resurfacing works is then to be undertaken by Clare County Council.

This very welcome news was delivered last week to representatives of the community groups of Tidy Towns, Obair and the Village Residents Association at a meeting facilitated by Deputy Joe Carey T.D. with the Programme Manager of Irish Water and the appointed Contractors.

It has been a long eventful journey over many years but thankfully we will arrive at our destination in 2018.
