Mooghaun: Great work has
been carried out at Mooghaun
Fort car park. It has been
resurfaced and the wooden rail
removed by the OPW. There is
still some work to be done –
before the recent timber growth
the viewing stand offered a
strategically important view up
the estuaries of both the
Shannon and the Fergus, a
prehistoric route into the
interior of the country. It is
hoped some of the foliage on
the western side will be cut
away to make it possible to
view over the N18 and see as
far as Kilmaley, Kildysert,
Ballinacally and beyond. It is
also hoped that the coloured
table and map which pin
pointed the surrounding
parishes will be reinstated at
the viewing stand. The area is
being well visited daily by
people of all ages.
