**Tradraí Launches To Great Acclaim:** The largest crowd to ever attend the launch of Tradraí gathered in The Clubhouse on Friday evening. Newmarket-on-Fergus GAA released the thirty fifth edition of Tradraí at the weekend with a warm reception which included music and dance provided by younger members of the club.

In 1967, the club won the senior and intermediate club championship in the same year, a feat that was only previously achieved by Ruan in 1948. An article on the intermediate of the team recognises the feat in the magazine while Michael 'Gazzy' Collins a wing-back on the side and also a well-known figure within sporting circles was the guest of honour on Friday as he launched the latest Tradraí.
