Gathering at Ballysallagh Mass Rock

We have a number of Mass Rocks in our parish which are reminders of Penal times in Ireland between the mid 16th and 18th centuries. During those times Mass was celebrated in secret at remote gatherings. The Mass Rock was used as a meeting place and altar. Last August we had a lovely celebration at the Mass Rock in Ballycar. We are currently planning a gathering at a Mass Rock in Ballysallagh in the lands of Tony and Marie Costello. That Mass will be celebrated on Wednesday 26th August at 7.00pm. Tony and Marie have very kindly given us permission to use their land and we will oversee the parking at the site on that evening.

Rónán and Liam are well known Irish musicians both as singers for their respective bands Kíla and Hot House Flowers as solo artists. They are among the best bodhrán players in Ireland today and have earned huge acclaim within the music industry for their unique styles of playing and their contribution to the world and traditional music genres in Ireland. They will play a very special full length show at the Irish Traditional Music Institute @ the beautiful Beechlawn House in Newmarket on Fergus.
