The Tidy Towns work schedule to include painting, planter, shrub and bed planting and floral basket displays is nearing completion and the weekly maintenance programme for the months of June, July & August are now a priority. All help would be welcome and much appreciated when we meet on Thursday evenings at 7.30pm and on the First & Last Saturday of each month at 10.30am. Meet at The Fairgreen.

Bunratty Local Development Association

A considerable amount of work has taken place to date, which has made a huge difference to the appearance of the village, a big thank you to all who have contributed their valuable time so far. The application for the Tidy Towns Competition 2013, has been submitted. Judging takes place 8 to 10 weeks after submission, and is carried out unannounced on any day of the week by the area judges.

We now need plenty of support to enable us to maintain, and water the beds, planters and baskets and to also complete the outstanding jobs. Your help is really needed, and will be appreciated. To accommodate everyone's busy lives, and to enable more volunteers to get involved, the job list is broken down into to parts.

The first list can be carried out at anytime on any day that's suits you. The second list needs more than four volunteers to carry out the work until the jobs are complete.

First Job List. (Continuous Maintenance for the rest of the Summer)

Weeding of Box Hedge Flowers Beds / Strimming / Edging of both greens, around trees and signage and strimming around road signs at the flyover. Weeding around beech hedging at Bunratty Search & Rescue Centre and Creamery Fencing.

Second Job List.

Wednesday evenings 6pm onwards to 8.30 pm. and Saturday Mornings 9 am - 1. Finish preparing the verge between Fennessey's and the Courtyard, and spread grass seed. Finish power washing the bridge. Clear all cuttings, branches and waste from the green next to the Creamery. Clear all weeds from Creamery wall to monument. Check, deadhead and water all planters and baskets every Wednesday and Saturdays. (Two or more people continuously throughout the summer)
