His face in every flower

Every facet of the natural world reveals the reality of God's presence, but few are more immediate and accessible than plants. On this special day we explore the spring flowers on our doorstep – 'the lilies of the field' – and set out to explore how 'even Solomon, in all his glory, was not clothed as one of these.'

Our day begins with an introductory lecture, followed by exploration of the Rainforest on our Doorstep – in this case the grounds of Dalgan Park – to meet 'the lilies of the field.' In the afternoon, we will look at the flowers with the new eyes given to us by the microscope.
