

Since the new board took over the running of the Community Centre in August 2012 significant progress has been made in restoring the complex to a steady state of repair. There is just one urgent task to be completed, the disposal of roof rain water, there is funding and a plan in place to have this completed in the next 30 days. The benefits of the completed restoration work is plain to see and the usage of the Community Centre has significantly increased in recent months. The Brass Band have recently taken up residence, tuition and practice take place three nights a week, Diarmuid O'Leary and Padraig Delaney have spearheaded children's hurling training in conjunction with the schools three nights a week. The Centre is also actively seeing more bookings for party events such as children's birthday parties Irish Dancing Competitions and they are local businesses well placed to provide catering at a reasonable cost.

The Board will next focus on the more interesting task of preparing a long term development plan for the Centre.

The first part of this will be a public consultation to establish the needs of the Community in the future. The first step on this exciting road of the development begins with a public meeting on Friday February 22nd at 8:30 in the Community Centre. This is the first opportunity for the Board elected in August 2012 to have sometime to listen to the Community. We are looking forward to engaging with everyone from pre-school to senior citizens with a view to having a Community Centre that meets your needs. The complex consists of two large halls, a number of meeting rooms, a handball court, a squash court with showers and changing rooms.
