The latest meeting was today and updates were given on the \notin 40 million made available around the country for such work, the grant being administered by Pobal. It will be spent in the areas of

- Accommodation
- Food supplies
- Alleviation of Poverty
- Promotion of Mental Health

Wellbeing Project for all Citizens

A detailed update was given by Helen Walsh the county librarian who is promoting the Wellbeing Project. A book delivery service is up and running for cocooners. Many e-resources are available for elearning, e-books, e-audiobooks, e-magazines.

Arts and Culture supports are being promoted through on-line media. Glór sa bhaile are offering on-line entertainment. Well being packs are available for the elderly. Various project are being designed for the road to recovery, things like virtual tours of local museums, toy and sensory resources and other items. Much of the detail is available on the Clare County Council Website.

Much work is continuing to be done by the many voluntary groups set up and as we get closer and closer to the time of less restrictions more and more people are volunteering their time.

The Alzheimer Society of Ireland have experienced huge disruption to our regular calendar of fundraising events due to the restrictions in place to ensure public safety, leading to a drop in income.
