Safeguarding Audit Report

On Monday the 12th May, the Diocese of Killaloe published the audit report from the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland. The audit of safeguarding practices in the diocese took place in November 2013.

Bishop O'Reilly stated that "the Board conducted a comprehensive audit of safeguarding practice in the diocese and have made four recommendations". On behalf of the diocese, Bishop O'Reilly accepted these recommendations and thanked the Board for their work.

On behalf of the Diocese of Killaloe he extended heartfelt apologies to all those who suffered abuse at the hands of a small number of priests of the diocese and stated: "I would like to assure parents and children that the diocese is committed to ensuring that best practices are in place and operational at all times to safeguard children now and in the future."

Community Centre and Handball Courts urgent funds appeal

There has great progress in the last month in relation to the Community Centre. White Horse Insurance recently funded the cost of the paint and provided free labour on Thursday April 24th to paint the Main Sports Hall.

This brings the value of the refurbishment on the centre in the past 18 months to \leq 40,000. Three major tasks remain to be completed to put the Handball Courts and the Community Centre in a reasonable state of repair.

The current Board will mark the 2nd anniversary of their appointment on August 16th and they are keen to have the following completed before then.

- 1. The replacement of the rainwater gutters on the handball courts.
- 2. The repair of the flat roof between the Temperance Hall and the Main Sports Hall.
