## **Cycle Against Suicide (CAS) Upcoming social and Fund- raising event**

All proceeds from our Orange Tie Ball goes to our schools' programme. According to UNICEF's latest report card on child well-being, "Ireland has the fourth highest teen suicide rate in the EU/OECD region." The report card warns that one in 10,000 Irish youth aged 15-19 will die by suicide. The report further shows that in younger teens, aged 11-15, "more than 22% report having experienced two or more psychological symptoms more than once a week." Our schools' programme, of which many schools in Limerick and Clare participate, is about educating students around mental health, addressing stigma and building resilience.

Join with Cycle Against Suicide at it's annual "**Orange Tie Ball**" on **November 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm at The Inn at Dromoland** to help raise awareness about this important issue.
