Danny was born with a condition called HLH which affected his immune system. He was healthy for his first 3 weeks of life but unfortunately he then became very sick very fast. He was treated in ICU in Crumlin Children's hospital for 3 weeks and was then transferred to Great North Children's Hospital in Newcastle where he remained for 6 months, eventually receiving a bone marrow transplant.

Thankfully Danny has fully recovered and is now a healthy and happy little boy. We are so grateful for all the help and support we received during the 7 months we were in hospital with Danny and we want to help other families living the same nightmare situation. Any money we raise will go towards helping with accommodation costs for families for whom hospital has become home in both Crumlin and Newcastle.
