O'Regan Park Development:

Due to inclement weather conditions during the past few weeks there will be a delay in the opening of the O'Regan Park playground. The newly developed Park will now open in the 2nd week of October and members of the committee hope that everyone will come and join in for what promises to be a long-awaited fun opening event.

Work on Day Chapel commences

Work on the construction of the Day Chapel in Newmarket on Fergus Church will commence on this Monday, August 26th. The aisle to the right of the altar on the Ballycar Road side of the church will be screened off so as to serve as a comfortable space for those who attend daily Mass. Since the church is used by 50 to 60 people daily it was considered more economical to isolate that section by the use of a glazed screen. In that section the walls will be dry-lined on the inside and insulated. A new low level ceiling, with insulation, suspended below the existing roof will be put in place. This section of the church will be heated on a separate heating zone making it much more economical to heat. As well as daily Masses, this section of the church can be used for Sunday Masses and other church services. The users of this area will not be isolated from the remainder of the church as the screen is substantially a glazed screen. When structural works are complete and the furnishings in place we will have a chapel to accommodate about 60 people on a daily basis which is warm, comfortable and economical especially in winter time. Work on the chapel is scheduled for two calendar months.

To facilitate the progress of this work we will need to relocate for **weekday morning Masses**, Monday to Friday. Tony McMahon has very kindly offered us the use of the funeral home adjacent to the church.

From this Monday August 26th the 10.00am Mass will be celebrated in McMahon's funeral home.

Evening weekday Masses, weekend Masses, funerals and weddings will be celebrated as normal in church.

We trust that this arrangement will be satisfactory.
