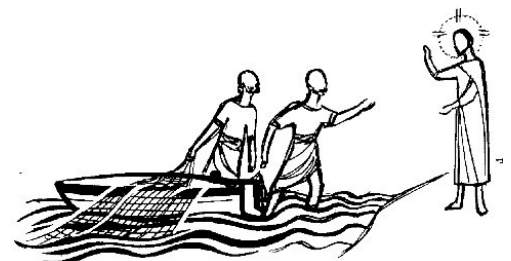

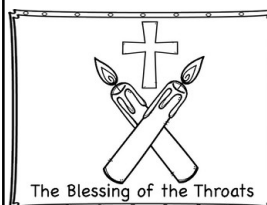


St Brigid: Feast day 1st February.

There are still many religious congregations dedicated to St. Brigid in existence today, including the Brigidine Sisters. This congregation was founded in 1807 by Bishop Daniel Delaney. This event was viewed as a re-founding of the Sisters of St. Brigid. The Brigidine Sisters established a base in Kildare in 1992 in order to honour their roots. They founded Solas Bhríde, which they describe as 'a small Christian centre for Celtic spirituality in the spirit of Brigid of Kildare.' Its focus is to 'work together to promote peace, justice, reconciliation and care of the earth.' The influence of St. Brigid is still extremely strong, not only in Ireland but across the world, with many festivals being held to celebrate her feast day on 1st February each year.

Fatima Hour : Saturday 1st February is the first in the month and the Rosary will be recited from 2pm to 3pm continually. Your company will be very welcome.

2nd February is Candlemas Day. It is the time of year when people traditionally had candles blessed for use in their home or donated candles for church use. If anyone wishes to have candles blessed or donate candles please leave them in the sacristy of your local church. Candles will be blessed at all masses next weekend.



The Blessing of Throats is a sacramental of the Roman Catholic Church, ordinarily celebrated on February 3rd, the feast day of Saint Blaise of Sebaste. The blessing of throats will take place at all Masses next weekend 1st /2nd February.
