## Blessed Pope John XXIII and Blessed Pope John Paul II to be declared saints today.

Blessed Pope John XXIII, known particularly for calling the Second Vatican Council, was pope from 1958 to 1963. During the council, he dealt with issues concerning the Church and the Modern World. He came to be known as "Good Pope John," and upon his death some of the Cardinals of the Second Vatican Council wanted to canonize him immediately. Blessed John Paul beatified him in 2000.



Blessed Pope John Paul II was known as a globetrotter visiting 129 countries on 104 trips outside Italy, and he served as pope from 1978 to 2005 and was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI on Divine Mercy Sunday, May 1, 2011. People will remember the assassination attempt on his life in 1981 and how he went to visit the man who tried to kill him. Again a true witness of God's mercy and forgiveness by a man who strived for peace in his life. Pope John Paul gave a great witness during his final year as Pope, using his sickness as a witness but also choosing not to suffer in private.



It is fitting that John Paul II and John XXIII will be canonized today on this Divine Mercy Sunday. Both Popes spoke about peace and mercy and both brought such mercy into the world. Let us pray, that through their intercession as saints, the heavens will open wide and even the most hardened hearts will accept God's gift of Divine Mercy.

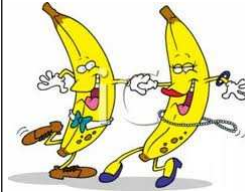
