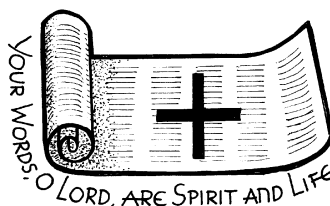

**Contract signed**

Contracts have recently been signed with Grangemore Plants, a renowned landscaping company. This was a milestone in the work of the O'Regan Park Development committee who was formed end of April 2012 with the aim to create a recreation park for young and old in the village of Newmarket-on-Fergus. The "Turning of the Sod" will take place early February, a delay of a few weeks due to the current weather conditions.

"We are absolutely thrilled!" a spokesperson said. "We can't wait to see the work start!"

Asked what the building works will mean to the village, the spokesperson explained "The two entrances to the park will be closed off for safety purposes. Grangemore will go up and down the paths with heavy machinery and we need to ensure that nobody gets endangered. We hope, that people will understand this as it will be only a temporary measure."
