
You can feel confident that the money raised works hard as ever towards the delivery of lifesaving and life-changing programmes in research, patient support, resuscitation, prevention and advocacy.

Our most recent campaign on Atrial Fibrillation is saving lives. Afib is the most common type of irregular heartbeat. It means a heart might not be pumping as well as it should. As a result, blood clots are more likely to form increasing the risk of having a stroke. The condition affects up to 40,000 people in Ireland and it can increase a person's stroke risk five-fold. Around 30% of strokes in Ireland are associated with Afib.

Despite these dangers, Atrial Fibrillation usually has no symptoms but can be detected by a pulse check and can then be treated effectively. We have produced online resources as well as an information booklet to help people to recognise and understand this condition

Thank you once again and to Christopher Ryan who organises a team of collectors for the three churches in Newmarket on Fergus parish for all your assistance in helping the Irish Heart Foundation to continue its good work.
