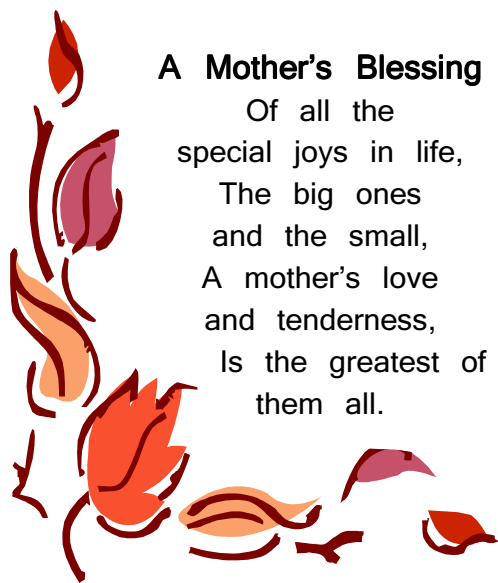

SEINN 2014 CONCERT

On April 3 the first Seinn concert will take place in the University Concert Hall, Limerick, featuring almost 500 secondary school students from the Dioceses of Limerick and Killaloe singing liturgical music - it will be a concert not to be missed!!!

Seinn is a new music initiative of the Dioceses of Limerick and Killaloe aimed at promoting liturgical music in second level schools. The dioceses have engaged the services of **Ian Callanan**, one of Ireland's leading composers of liturgical music, to be the musical director of the programme. The programme provides schools with a resource of liturgical music for use at various celebrations and by extension it teaches and promotes good liturgical music which will be of benefit to parishes. Therefore we encourage choirs from the parishes of the dioceses to attend and hear this year's music programme.

The central part of the project is a day-long event involving about almost 500 second level students which this year takes place on 3 April on the UL Campus. It involves a day of workshops and rehearsals culminating in a major concert in the Concert Hall with up to 500 students involved between singing and playing in the orchestra.

The Seinn 2014 Concert will feature students from 21 schools throughout Limerick, Clare, Tipperary and Offaly. They will perform 22 songs with an orchestra of almost 30 instrumentalists drawn from the schools together with several professional musicians. The concert is at 8pm and all tickets are €10 - available from the University Concert Hall, Limerick and www.uch.ie.
