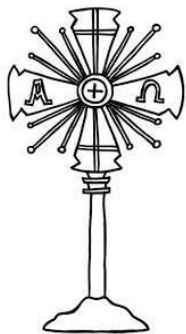

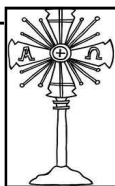
Year Of Mercy Pilgrimage To The Holy Land

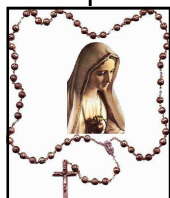
First Friday
