UL Hospitals Group has this week launched a new poster campaign to raise awareness about the services provided by its Local Injury Units (LIUs) in St. John's Hospital, Limerick, Nenagh and Ennis Hospitals. LIUs are locally based services treating minor injuries in patients from the age of 5 years upwards. They are a safe alternative to the Emergency Department (ED) for a number of injuries and conditions. Patients coming to the LIU are generally seen, treated and discharged within an hour of arrival, they can either self refer or get a GP referral.

Some of the injuries that can be safely treated at the LIUs in all patients from 5 upwards, include suspected broken bones; all sprains and strains; wounds, bites, cuts, grazes and scalp lacerations; minor facial injuries; minor scalds and burns, small abscesses and boils; minor head injury.

Some of the injuries and conditions that cannot be treated at the LIUs include any injury to a child under five years of age; conditions due to medical illness (e.g. chest pain / respiratory conditions); serious head injury; abdominal pain; gynaecological problems; pregnancy related problems; injuries due to self-harm; suspected serious injury or inability to walk following a fall t or a motor vehicle collision; chest pain, abdominal pain or shortness of breath; spine, pelvis or hip fractures and patients with neck pain or back injury that started on the day of the injury.
