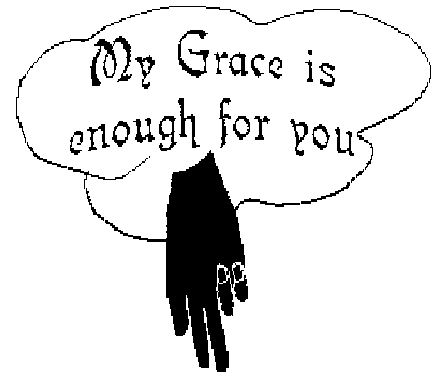

Newmarket Tidy Towns:

Newmarket Tidy Towns have once again been busy with the most recent projects including a
clean-up at Knocksaggart and the Dromoland approach road, new Bring Bank signage and
partnering with Newmarket Celtic in giving a makeover to the shrub bed on the Ennis Road.
However, the past week has seen damage to many of the hanging baskets on Main Street &
Ballycar Road. This behaviour is of major disappointment for the Tidy Town volunteers and for
the resident, sporting organisations and business owners who are playing their part in keeping
Newmarket looking its best. With replacement baskets in place the Tidy Towns Committee are
asking the community to be vigilant and to report such anti-social behaviour to the appropriate
authorities.
