Welcome Catrina Sheridan!

This weekend we welcome **Catrina Sheridan** to talk to us about the work of Trócaire. The Trócaire Lent Campaign this year is about the global water crisis. Drier climates across sub-Saharan Africa are leaving communities struggling without enough water for drinking, sanitation and growing food. **Enestina** (9) is the girl on this year's Trócaire box. She comes from a small community in Malawi that has relied on a polluted river for drinking and washing for many years. She journeys 2km with 20 litres of water every morning before school. She is one of the millions of women and girls who make the hazardous journey to wells every day in search of water. The community depends on the unpredictable rains to water their crops, meaning that they never know what food they can produce. Trócaire is working to change this.

By now you will have received your Trócaire boxes and envelopes. Towards the end of Lent we will identify a time for returning these to the Parish so that we as a Christian Community can be generous in helping those people in Malawi to provide a basic necessity for life and living.
