

You buy the items on the list, ensuring that expiry dates are non-perishable and have an expiry date well into 2015.

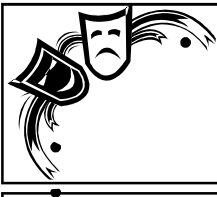
When your collection is over, drop the food to your local Regional Office or drop-off point.
