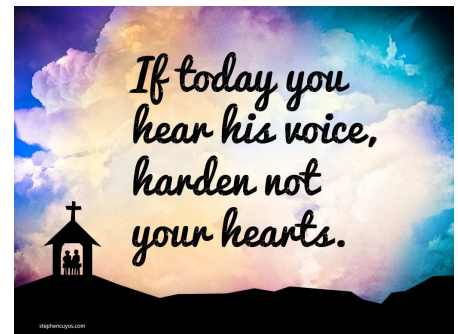

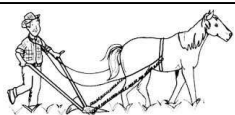

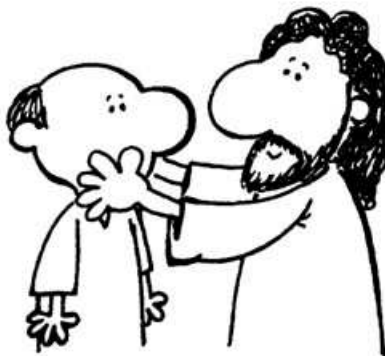
Please note this event is open **to all bereaved parents**, regardless of the age of their child or the circumstances of their death.
