The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

The Church of St John on the Lateran in Rome is 'Mother and Head of all the churches in the City and the World'. It is a cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome, and was called 'St John' after the two monasteries once attached, dedicated to St John the Divine and St John the Baptist. It is however dedicated to the Most Holy Saviour.
