Over 200 took part in 2012 and the organisers, Shannon AC in conjunction with local soccer club BunrattyCratloe FC, are expecting an even bigger turn-out this year. Event t-shirts are being given out to the first 200 participants registered.

The 10K race has been granted an AAI Permit, with cash prizes for the first three runners, plus first home in ladies and various age-categories. A bonus prize of €100 is also on offer if a new course record set. Last year's winner Thomas Fitzpatrick of Dublin set the standard at 31:46 at his leisure, as he went on to run 30:03 in the Great Ireland Run a week later and has previously run sub-30 minutes for the distance. 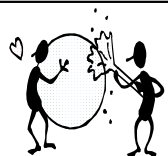
