DONATIONS TO OUR PARISH:

Thank you to everyone who supports in any way the upkeep of our churches, priests' houses & salary and the work of the office through contributions during the year. Along with your contributions the parish as an eligible charity can avail of the benefit of reclaiming tax on donations that amount to €250 or more in each year. In 2020 we received €20,850.78 based on your contributions. Originally once parishioners commenced working they were automatically added to the system. This is no longer the case. If you are contributing to the church collections and are not receiving parish envelopes please let the parish office know if you would like to have envelopes. This is the system we use to record contributions. Boxes of envelopes are distributed to households throughout the parish during the latter part of June by 34 long serving and very dedicated parishioners. Those who are accustomed to receiving envelopes will notice that the envelope number assigned to you will be changed from July 2021. Now and then there is a need to rearrange envelope numbers to keep the chronology in order and reduce any waste of boxes due to inactive numbers. Over the last few years we have nearly 100 boxes left over after distribution, some people move to another parish and sadly some parishioners pass away. With the old system those numbers became inactive. The system we are working with now facilitates renumbering every year if required. We haven't decided yet if we will renumber envelopes annually (let's see how this year goes first!!). Our year runs from July 1st to June 30th. We changed to summer distribution some years ago as we felt it was unreasonable to expect distributors to go out on dark winter evenings.

Again we thank you most sincerely for your continued support.
