## PARISH ENVELOPES:

Thank you to everyone who supports in any way the upkeep of our churches, priests' houses & salary and the work of the office through contributions during the year. The new boxes of envelopes are being distributed these weeks and can be used from the first weekend in July. The envelope number assigned to you 2021 is changed commencing from July.

Thank you also to those who returned CHY3 certs recently. As an eligible charity we can avail of the benefit of reclaiming tax on donations that amount to €250 or more in each year. In 2020 we received from Revenue €20,850.78 based on your contributions. ## BAPTISMS IN THE PARISH

While First Communions and Confirmations have been postponed due to the latest surge in the Corona Virus, Bishop Fintan has been in contact to say that if it is deemed pastorally necessary and appropriate then Baptisms can proceed but with minimal attendees present; parents, God-parents, grandparents, immediate household. He has also asked that no gatherings should take place afterwards. Hopefully there will be more encouraging news on the guidelines in the near future following the extended efforts being made by everyone in the huge efforts to beat the virus.

## IRISH RED CROSS CLARE – SUPPORTING THE PEOPLE OF CO. CLARE

Hello Everyone, The Irish Red Cross in Clare travel to all corners of Co. Clare and to hospitals all over Ireland five to six days a week support the people of Co. Clare. There is a big demand on our Community Support Services and it is not possible to look after everyone at this time.

We in the Irish Red Cross Clare and in the process of purchases our second Community Support vehicle, which will be new for the people of Co. Clare for medical appointments and this should be in place in late July 2021 costing €59,000.00. one wheel-chair space + four seats.

In 2016 we received a donation for €2,000.00 from Trump organisation for our existing vehicle which cost €86,000.00 and once again we have received a voucher for two nights for two people B&B in a court yard Bedroom. We have decided to raffle the voucher for €10.00 a ticket up to 500 tickets. We need your support in making this raffle a success and in doing so supporting the people of Co. Clare with Medical appointments. So as ye aware the raffle is live and really needs to be pushed so as we can get a good response for this.
