

Hello Everybody

The Irish Red Cross Clare have been providing a service to the people of Co. Clare since August 2016, when we purchased our first Community Support Vehicle at a cost of \in 86,000.00. Thanks to all our volunteers drivers and community support teams we have been on the road five to six day a week since 2016 supporting the people of Co. Clare with medical appointments.

Our community support service is such a vital roll carried out by our volunteers. The number of young and old, disabled and able bodied, people living alone that have no family and members of the general public that rely on our great volunteers to get them to hospital appointments, doctor visits, eye appointments, out patients, cancer treatment, and a gold range of reasons that they may need to come to or from is astounding.

We bring people from all corners of Co. Clare to hospitals all over Ireland. Sometimes their day can start at 3am just to have someone from some distant corner of Clare in Dublin for an 8 or 9am appointment.

That very same person will be brought from their door to their destination, assisted to attend their appointment and brought home to their family when all is done.

We also promote social outing visiting nursing homes taking the residents for day trips organised by the nursing homes. Our service to the community are making a difference in people's life's.

We are turning away to many clients and here is the good news, we have purchased a second community support Vehicle at a cost of €61,315.50
