Re-opening Parish Life in light of the Governments most recent Covid-19 announcements

Ireland has entered a new phase in the relaxation of pandemic restrictions. In light of the Governments most recent announcement and in an effort to keep people safe and feeling secure when coming to pray in our Churches, the following guidelines will continue to apply in our parish.

- Face Coverings **remain a requirement** within the Church building
- **Hand sanitising stations** are to be used on entry into the Church.
- While public communal worship is now open to greater numbers we **will continue to maintain our social distancing measures**. For example the use of every second pew and the following our directional arrows when moving around the Church.
- At weekend Masses the distribution of communion **will continue** to be given to people in their seats.
- At weekday Mass **continue** to follow the directional arrows when coming to, and returning from Communion. Maintain the 2 meter distancing coming to and from communion.
 - Communicants receive Holy Communion on the **hand only**.
 - Holy Water fonts will remain empty but Holy Water can be collected for home use .
 - Collections will continue to be taken up at the **entrance doors** in the boxes provided.
- Sanitisation of the Church after Mass and other gatherings **will continue** until further notice.

We take this opportunity to thank you for your continued cooperation. A special word of thanks to all our wonderful Volunteer Stewards and Sanitising Teams. We also thank our Eucharistic Minister, Readers and Sacristans for their outstanding and continued service in these challenging times.
