Dates for Sacraments

Due to the ongoing and growing uncertainty with regard to Covid-19 we are unable at this time to publish definite dates for First Holy Communion and Confirmation. At the earliest opportunity we will publish a draft schedule but at this stage it will most probably be early in the new year before we can do this with any degree of certainty. We will keep the schools, parents and children of the sacramental classes updated if and when we have any additional information.
