Community Centre Refurbishment Fund

Since the Community Centre re-opened on February 3rd this year has been a hectic 3 months of activity, including the booking of new activities such as The Tradaree Bridge Club (Thursday nights), The Going Strong Club (Wednesday 2pm to 4pm) and the Youth Club run by Clare Youth Service (Fridays from 6pm to 9pm). Dance Attack Stage Academy have finished for the summer, hopefully they will be back again in the Autumn and the LCETB run courses for Yoga and Art & Drawing are due to finish up in May.

The good news is that the Board of Directors plan to keep the social Dancing going until August subject to the availability of bands. The regular activities of Beavers, Cubs and Scouts, Karate, Medieval Sword and Bingo continue every week.

Now that the long evenings are here the directors have time to focus on clearing the \pounds 100,000 loan which, together with grant funding of \pounds 350,000, paid for the refurbishment of the toilets, dressing rooms, office and meeting rooms. All who have visited the Centre in the last 3 months have been very impressed with the quality of the work. All the local businesses have been generous in their sponsorship of the development. In the coming weeks the directors will be calling door-to-door to all the houses in the parish seeking a contribution from each household.

In these inflationary times money is always in short supply but the record of the people of Newmarket supporting the Community Centre, which is a facility for all since the days of Fr. Tim Touhy, has been commendable, and all donations are gratefully received.
