## Diocesan Clerical Changes 2022

This weekend sees the clerical changes for 2022 take effect across the Diocese of Killaloe. The Pastoral Area of Tradaree says goodbye to Fr. Francis who leaves Shannon to take up his new appointment in the Parish of Toomevara. We give thanks for all he contributed to this Pastoral Area and we wish him every blessing in his future ministry. Over the coming weeks and months we will be reflecting as a Pastoral Area as to how best we can adjust to the loss of such a key member from our Pastoral Area Team.

We wish our own Co-PP Fr. Michael, every blessing in his new role as Vicar Forane (VF) of the Pastoral Area of Tradaree. In short, this means that he has been charged by Bishop Fintan to oversee and coordinating the pastoral, liturgical and day to day life of this Pastoral Area which includes the parishes of Newmarket on Fergus, Shannon and Sixmilebridge. He has also being asked to collaborate with Fr. Harry Bohan in Sixmilebridge, with particular involvement in the primary schools of that parish. Fr. Michael will continue in his interim role as Diocesan Advisor to Post Primary Schools across the Diocese of Killaloe. In this role he is charged to support the important work of Religion Teachers, Chaplains and Pastoral Care Teams in secondary schools of our Diocese.

The Diocesan changes highlight yet again the changing reality we are living through as Church. As one of the larger Pastoral Areas in the Diocese we have now three priest under the age of 75 and two men giving great service well beyond the official retirement age of 75. With God's help, and our combined efforts, we will negotiate this time of change in a lifegiving and faith filled way.

The Turnpike Road 1733-1832 Part 3 : William Bourne, Charles Bianconi, John and Margaret Jaspar, Daniel O'Connell, Donough, the 4<sup>th</sup> Earl and 6<sup>th</sup> Earl Barnabas and his successors the Lords Egremont and Leconfield, The McNerneys of Carrigoran and Knockslattery were names rolling off the tongues of the twenty four travellers on the Turnpike Road last Saturday. Eddie Moloney present owner of the Ardsollus Toll House reminded us that there are few original bridge toll houses, in occupation. Martin and Margaret Liddy of Jaspar's Pound showed a picture of an older house at their site, probably the home of the O'Dea family and that of the Burkes whose history is recorded online @Jaspar's Pound. Catering was by Reynolds and Co., Mooghaun, Maps from Mary B McMahan, John Ryan in charge of sound control. Sheila McGrath wrote and delivered a well-informed script on the Jaspar family. Mike McCormack and Brendan Reynolds provided the difficulty for a priest making a sick call to the Ardsollus House which was divided between the Newmarket and Doora parish.
