The Parish Walk 17th September : It might have been a rear view shot of the L'Arc de Triomphe, the over hundred feet high, majestic and beautifully - constructed arch of the railway bridge spanning the river Rine at Ballykilty. Part of the early seventeenth century road crossed the river Rine about one hundred metres north east of the bridge and the ford rather than the bridge was the goal of our parish walk. A tunnel on the same structure as the bridge allowed us to cross the neighbouring field. The main Limerick Ennis Road traffic via Quin, passed through the ford where lanterns were lit by locals, some say by the friars at Quin, when dusk fell. Hence the name, Áth Sholais, the Ford of Light, now Ardsollus. One mile south of the ford is Ardsollus Bridge over which the turnpike road passed. The race course of the eighteenth century stretched south of the railway line to Ardsollus toll house. Thanks to everyone who facilitated this walk, the land owner, the parish office and Mr E Moloney. Thanks posthumously to John Lloyd who in A Tour of Clare published in 1780 suggested an interpretation of Aylecotty renaming the Rine, as Ayle, from its source near Tulla so that an interpretation is Aill An Choite, the Boat River.
