End of an era on Main Street

Maria Keogh closed the post office in Main Street for the last time at 12.30 on Wednesday afternoon, 28th September. It was an emotional time for her as the building itself is the property of her family, as well as her work place. Its life as a post office began when, in 1885 John Moran, a career official from Roscommon, was transferred from Cavan. He leased the property from Nora Keogh and served as Postmaster until, at age 81 years, he retired. He was succeeded by his daughter, Sarah, who served as sub- postmistress until in 1949, she retired, aged 78. Having served the standard probation for two months, Seán Keogh was appointed Sub Postmaster, a position he retained until 1991, when his daughter Maria was appointed Sub Postmistress. In March 2007 the official address of the post office was Main Street Newmarket-on-Fergus, the office number was 2834.
