# The Feast of Christ the King – a little background.

The Feast of Jesus Christ our Universal King has been celebrated on this last Sunday of the liturgical year for almost a century. It points to Christ's Kingship and to the End of Time, when the kingdom of Jesus will be established in all its fullness to the ends of the earth. It leads directly into Advent, when we anticipate Christ's second coming. The devotion to Christ's Kingship was addressed in the encyclical *Quas Primas* of Pope Pius XI (1925), which quotes Cyril of Alexandria: 'Christ has dominion over all creatures, a dominion not seized by violence nor usurped, but by essence and by nature'. The Pope was reminding Christians that their allegiance was to their spiritual ruler in heaven rather than any earthly leader. Remember this was written at a time just before Europe was to witness the dire effects of what happens when we follow the wrong type of earthly leaders and the resultant effects in World War II.
