Community Centre going Green



The announcement of €285,000 in funding for the Community Centre on Dec 20th is very good news for the people of Newmarket-on-Fergus and the surrounding parishes who make up most of the users of the Community Centre and the handball and squash courts.

The funding will enable the board of directors to install solar panels on the south facing roof of the main hall, convert all bulbs to LEDs and refurbish the main hall so that it is insulated. All of these works will help reduce the energy costs which have been a cause of concern for all in 2022.

When this project is complete the spend on the Community Centre since 2021 will be $\[\in \]$ 760,000 which together with the $\[\in \]$ 100,000 spent between 2012 and 2020 brings the total to almost $\[\in \]$ 900,000.
