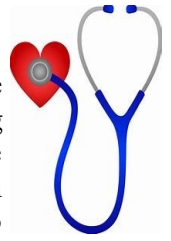
**Retention of a Medical Practice in Newmarket on Fergus

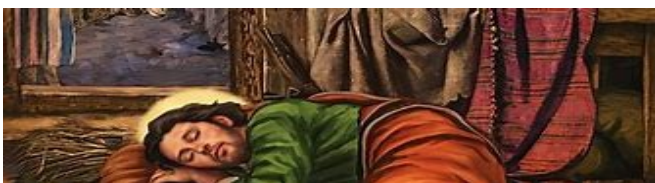
Newmarket On Fergus GAA Lotto
