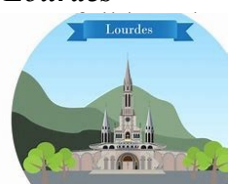

Diocesan Changes 2023

In the Diocesan Changes you will have read: *Fr. Michael Collins, COPP, VF, Tradaree Pastoral Area, resident in Newmarket on Fergus to be Vicar for Mission and Ministry, while continuing to minister in Tradaree with cover from the Pastoral Area as required.* The implications of this appointment coupled with Fr. Michael's role as Chair of the Council of Priests and acting DA for Secondary Schools means that Fr. Michael now will have three significant appointments at Parish, Pastoral Area and Diocesan level. The Diocese envisages that Fr. Michael will give 2 to 3 days a week (including evenings) to his appointment as Vicar for Mission and Ministry in the Diocese. This is going to result in a significant draw on Fr. Michael's time. In the coming weeks Fr. Michael will be exploring what this will mean for how he ministers in the Parish of Newmarket and in our Pastoral Area. Fr. Michael in conjunction with the other priests in the Pastoral Area wish to ensure that the Pastoral and Spiritual needs of this community continue to be met.

Lady's Irish Open 2023 Community Festival 2nd & 3rd September 2023



This week Clare Co. Council announced their plans, in conjunction with the Lady's Irish Open in Dromoland Golf Club, to host a Community Festival in Newmarket on Fergus on Saturday 2nd and Sunday the 3rd of September. This festival will take place on the Ballycar Road and on the "Green" or carpark in front of Our Lady of the Rosary Church. As a gesture of good will, and in an effort to facilitate this community event, the Saturday Evening Mass on Saturday the 2nd of September will be moved to The Wells Church. While this may be a source of inconvenience we believe that hosting Mass in Our Lady of the Rosary Church with the planned traffic restrictions, the lack of a parking and envisaged music and events would be much more difficult for ourselves as a praying community and for the event organisers. Clare Co Council have assured us that we will be able to conduct Mass as normal on Sunday the 3rd. There will be more details to follow in the coming weeks. We thank you for your understanding and we hope that our cooperation will help towards the success of this community and family event.
