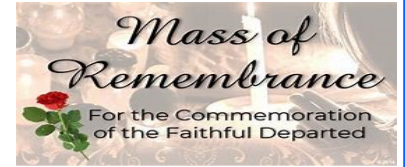
Mass of Remembrance

Make the sign of the cross, In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.

Pray together: Father in heaven, as we stand before the resting place of our beloved (name of person), we remember the gift they were and continue to be to each of us here present. We thank you for their life, the love they shared with us and we pray that they are with you now, enjoying the fullness of eternal life. Comfort us in our sadness, strengthen us with your hope, until we are united with them again in the love of Christ and we are with you and our loved one forever. Amen.

Sprinkle the grave with Holy Water Pray together: one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Glory be and finish by praying: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let Your perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace. Amen

Conclude by making the sign of the cross. In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.
