Parish Envelopes

Every year several parishioners deliver the boxes of church envelopes around the parish. We are very grateful to you all for your commitment over many years. This year the office is later than is customary with preparing the boxes. We hope to have them ready for distributers by Friday 20th June.

Some changes:

For this year only the boxes will cover an 18 month period (July 2025 to Dec 2026). Delivering the envelopes in the middle of the year has created some problems with the management of this system. It is necessary to sometimes change the numbers allocated to facilitate being more organised and less wasteful by keeping numbers condensed. Over the last few years many gaps have appeared in the numbers for various reasons thus generating several boxes of unused envelope numbers.

There may be people who wish to receive a box of envelopes who have not to date, or others that are receiving them and perhaps would rather not. We'd appreciate it if you would let us know by contacting the parish office 061 368127 or by emailing: office@newmarketonfergusparish.ie. Paying direct to the parish bank account and or using the donate button on our website have become more popular in recent years. Of these two methods paying directly to the bank is more beneficial.
