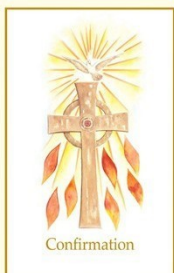

It is a significant milestone in a Catholic's spiritual journey, marking the completion of their initiation into the Church. 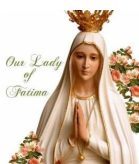
Clare SVP Seeking Volunteers
