May Geraldine's gentle soul Rest in God's Love.

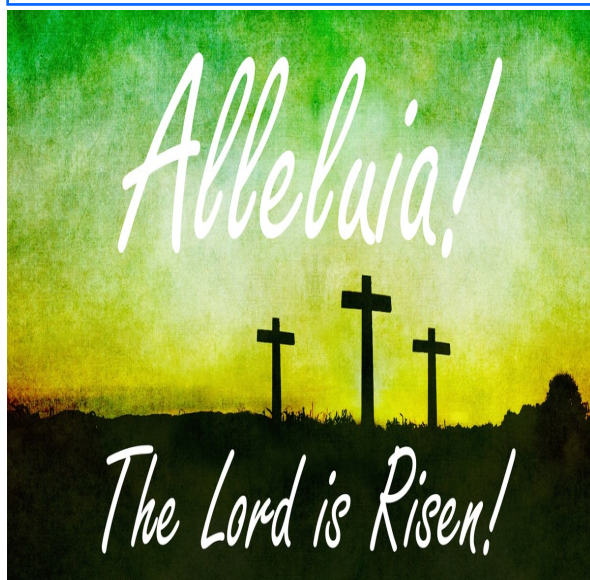
We continue to hold Mary (Cusack) in our prayers that God will restore her to good health and comfort her in her sorrow.
