And held the broken, the poor, the weak.

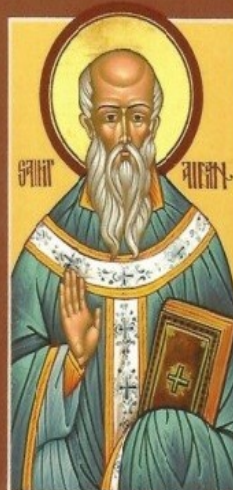
When hearts are weary, help us to care,
